

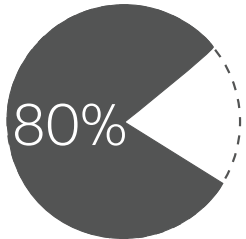

Fewer resources and tighter budgets are making it more difficult for government attorneys to manage an ever-increasing and more diverse workload.

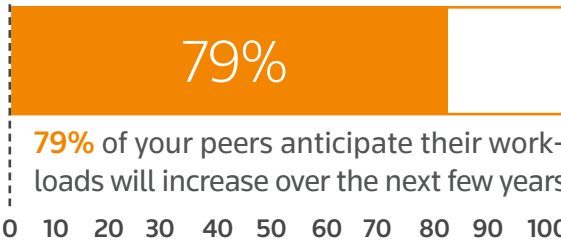
LIMITED RESOURCES
